- Hui Ke (2nd Patriarch, 486-593)

本来缘有地,

因地种花生。

本来无有种,

花亦不曾生。

Flower seed grows because of the land. It is from the land the flower grows. No one plants the seed, The land has no flower generated.

- Seng Can (3rd Patriarch, 500-606)

花种虽因地,

从地种花生。

若无人下种,

花地尽无生。

Flower seed has the growing nature.

- Dao Xin (4th Patriarch, 580-651)

花种有生性,

因地果还生。

- Hui Neng (6th Patriarch, 638-713)
